

K D University, Mathura a University approved vide U.P. Ordinance No. 12 of 2025 at 4/51/2025 and consisting therein healthcare, research and academic institutions, located at Village – Akbarpur, 23 Km milestone, NH-19 (Mathura-Delhi Road), Mathura, Uttar Pradesh - 281406 (hereinafter referred to as “Medical College”).

The Technical College and the Medical College are hereinafter collectively referred to as “the Parties” and individually as “a Party.”

2. Purpose of the MoU

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for mutual cooperation between the Parties to undertake collaborative activities in:

1. Research & Development (R&D) initiatives
2. Biomedical engineering and healthcare technology development
3. Medical awareness and health education programs
4. Psychological counseling sessions and mental health support
5. Skill development and training programs for students and staff
6. Joint academic, clinical and technical Workshops, Seminars and Conferences

The Parties agree to work together to promote interdisciplinary knowledge exchange that benefits students, faculty, medical professionals and society at large.

3. Scope of Collaboration

3.1 Research & Development Activities

The Parties shall collaborate on:

- Joint R&D projects in biomedical devices, healthcare technologies, diagnostic systems, and digital health solutions.
- Establishing research laboratories or incubation centers (subject to mutual consent).
- Exchanging technical expertise, datasets and research findings.
- Encouraging joint publications, patents and technology transfer activities.

3.2 Medical Awareness Programs

The Medical College shall support the Technical College in:

- Organizing medical and public health awareness campaigns.
- Conducting sessions on preventive healthcare, first aid, nutrition, hygiene, communicable and non-communicable disease management.
- Hosting blood donation drives, health check-up camps, and vaccination initiatives.

3.3 Psychological Sessions and Mental Health Support

The Medical College shall support the Technical College in:

- Organize psychological counseling sessions and wellness workshops for students and staff.
- Conduct seminars on stress management, emotional well-being and behavioral health.

- Facilitate access to qualified psychologists or mental health professionals when required.

3.4 Training & Skill Development

- The Medical College may allow students from the Technical College to undergo observational training or internship programmes (non-clinical or as permitted by law).
- The Technical College may provide technical support, software solutions and engineering-related training to the Medical College staff.
- Both Parties may collaborate on certificate courses or short-term training modules.

3.5 Seminars, Conferences & Workshops

The Parties agree to co-organize:

- Interdisciplinary workshops, lectures and symposiums.
- Knowledge-sharing events involving medical and engineering faculty.
- Hackathons or innovation challenges focusing on healthcare technology.

4. Roles and Responsibilities

4.1 Responsibilities of the Technical College

- Provide necessary support, infrastructure or faculty expertise for collaborative R&D.
- Assist in developing engineering solutions for clinical or administrative problems identified by the Medical College.
- Maintain confidentiality of medical and patient-related information as required by law.
- Provide IT related technical support to the Medical College, as & when needed.
- Provide Web Support to develop, design and real-time updation of website of the Medical College.

4.2 Responsibilities of the Medical College

- Provide medical expertise, clinical knowledge and professional resources for research and awareness activities.
- Permit student visits, training, or observation sessions within permissible limits.
- Deliver medical and psychological awareness programs on the campus of Technical College.
- Facilitate student and faculty participation in Medical College-based awareness and training programs.
- Support collaborative publications, research projects and technological development.

5. Funding and Resource Allocation

- Each Party shall bear its own costs unless otherwise agreed in writing for a specific project.
- Joint projects may receive funding from external agencies subject to mutual consent in writing.
- Use of facilities and equipment shall be mutually decided based on availability and project requirements.

6. Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

- Any intellectual property arising out of collaborative work shall be jointly owned unless otherwise agreed in a project-specific agreement.
- Use, licensing and commercialization of jointly developed technologies shall require written consent from both Parties.

7. Medical Support

7.1 Medical Assistance

- In the event of any medical emergency involving students, faculty or staff of the Technical College within the campus or during Technical College-organized events, the Medical College agrees to provide immediate medical support on a priority basis.

7.2 First-Aid and Primary Care

- The Medical College shall make available essential **first-aid services**, including preliminary medical assessment and stabilization, either on-site or at the Medical College premises.

7.3 Ambulance Services

The Medical College shall provide **ambulance services** for the safe and prompt transportation of affected individuals to the Medical College or another appropriate medical facility.

- The ambulance shall be made available as early as possible upon receiving the request from Technical College authorities.
- Charges, if any, may be mutually agreed upon separately or covered under specific terms as decided by both Parties.

7.4 Coordination and Communication

- The Technical College shall designate an authorized point of contact for emergency communication. Likewise, the Medical College will assign a 24x7 emergency contact number or designated coordinator to ensure seamless coordination during medical emergencies.

7.5 Non-Liability Clause

- While the Medical College agrees to provide emergency support, it shall not be held liable for delays due to unavoidable circumstances beyond its control or for medical outcomes arising from the nature or severity of the emergency.

8. Confidentiality

- Both Parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of proprietary information, research data, patient information and other sensitive materials.

- Confidential information shall not be disclosed to third parties without prior written consent.

9. Validity and Duration

- This MoU shall remain valid for **three (3) years** from the date of signing unless terminated earlier.
- It may be extended through written consent by both Parties.

10. Amendment and Termination

- Any amendment to this MoU must be made in writing and signed by both Parties.
- Either Party may terminate the MoU by giving **30 days' prior written notice**.
- Activities in progress shall be completed or mutually resolved upon termination.

11. No Legal or Financial Obligation

This MoU is an expression of mutual intent and does not create any legal, financial or contractual commitments unless specified in subsequent agreements.

12. Dispute Resolution


